- The first Smrikva Bowl was organized in 1996.
- Smrikva Bowl's objective is to continue with its scouting of tennis talents and aims to become the strongest competition in Europe for players under 10.
- For the 7th Annual Smrikva Bowl over 60 boys and girls competed from 9 European Countries: Spain, Switzerland, Italy, Germany, Croatia, Slovenia, Hungary, Yugoslavia and Bosnia and Herzegovina.

- The event was hosted by the Austin Tennis Academy.
- The players representing the United States were: #1 Jordaan Sanford (California) and #2 Morgan Basil (Florida). The U.S. players were selected from the "Little Mo" Regional Champions, which features the best young players in the United States from 7-11 years of age. The players representing Europe were: #1 Ajla Tomljanovic (Croatia) and #2 Ema Burgic (Bosnia), selected from the top players of the Smrikva Bowl.

Each match is played up to 9 games; whoever loses in the first round of the main tournament plays in the consolation tournament. In the consolation tournament each match is played up to 6 games.

Saturday, 5th July 2003 (MAIN AND CONSOLATION TOURNAMENT CONTINUES)

- Sunday, 6th July 2003 (SEMIFINALS AND FINALS)
